Skeet & Trap - Thursday has been designated as skeet & trap day at the club. Every Thursday several members can enjoy the company and an afternoon of shooting. Come on out and join in.



Lake & Fishing – The lake is in good condition, there's fish to catch. You may bring a small boat as long as you do not use a gas motor and remember to use your life jacket. Swimming not allowed in the lake.



Other shooting ranges in the area – A new shooting range opened at Spring Creek. It has covered area for pistol shooting (25yds) and rifle shooting (50-100yds) and can accommodate about 6 shooters on each side, or more without cover above them. There is also toilet and parking area. The range is open during daylight hours and is closed on Tuesdays for law enforcement training. It replaces the old Spring Creek, Brush Creek and Thornburg (Parksville Lake) shooting ranges which have closed down.



Turkey season starts at April 1st - STATEWIDE SEASON - APRIL 1–MAY 14, 2006 All Tennessee counties are open to wild turkey hunting excluding WMAs and refuges unless specifically listed. **BAG LIMITS** A hunter may take a total of four bearded turkeys for the spring season. **Read all restrictions at** <http://www.state.tn.us/twra/huntmain.html>. **HUNTING HOURS:** Thirty minutes before sunrise to sunset (unless otherwise listed). **LEGAL HUNTING EQUIPMENT:** Shotguns and muzzleloading shotguns, 20 gauge or larger, loaded with No. 4 shot or smaller; long bows, compound bows and crossbows using legal hunting arrows with broadheads.
