- Discussion about a renewal form that is being created for the new year by Bill Aly and John Ivens. The new form will contain contact info on members to help keep the club roster up to date. Also discussed was the different types of members(Charter/ Life/ Senior/Annual) Annual members can upon reaching the age of 65 and having 3 consecutive years of a member in the club may request the board to grant them Senior member status, which requires no charge of dues for their continued membership.

- Ducks Unlimited (Cleveland) is having a fund raiser on 4 Nov 06 at Benton Sporting Clays in Benton. Tickets for banquet are \$45 for couples/ \$35 for singles/ \$10 for jr. - TVA land management/ a new board has been installed and they want to hear from the public as to how the public would like to see TVA handle their land management. A hand out was given to club members and more detailed information was given as to what and why this is important by Marty High
- New Pistol Range/ need to talk with Chief Zeigler about when Athens city will begin work (Bill Aly) Dis cussion was brought up about the possibility of using the old pistol range as a site to test patterns for shotguns. Question was raised about if the APD pays for the skeet they shoot. Chief Zeigler will be contacted about it. The club needs to check with MCSD to acquire a copy of their calendar for their club use.
- Club received a statement from George Inwood for mowing for August and September, total was \$70.00. We need to express our appreciation to George for taking care of this for the club. George has been very kind to the club in what he has charged. Also, he gave the club some info on how long it takes to mow the property and some idea of how much it costs. That will be brought up at the next meeting.

Opinion: TVA seeking feedback on land policy banning residential development

The deadline for feedback on TVA's proposed land policy is now three weeks away.

The TVA has never had a written policy for how to develop what's left of the 1.3 million acres it originally acquired. The policy would ban selling or using TVA shorelines for residential development, a major source of controversy. TVA is accepting public comments on the proposed policy through Nov. 3. 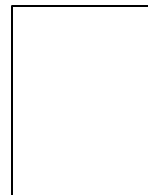
